

The following site map, newspaper articles and typed list are from the archives of the Westhampton Cemetery, Westhampton, NY.

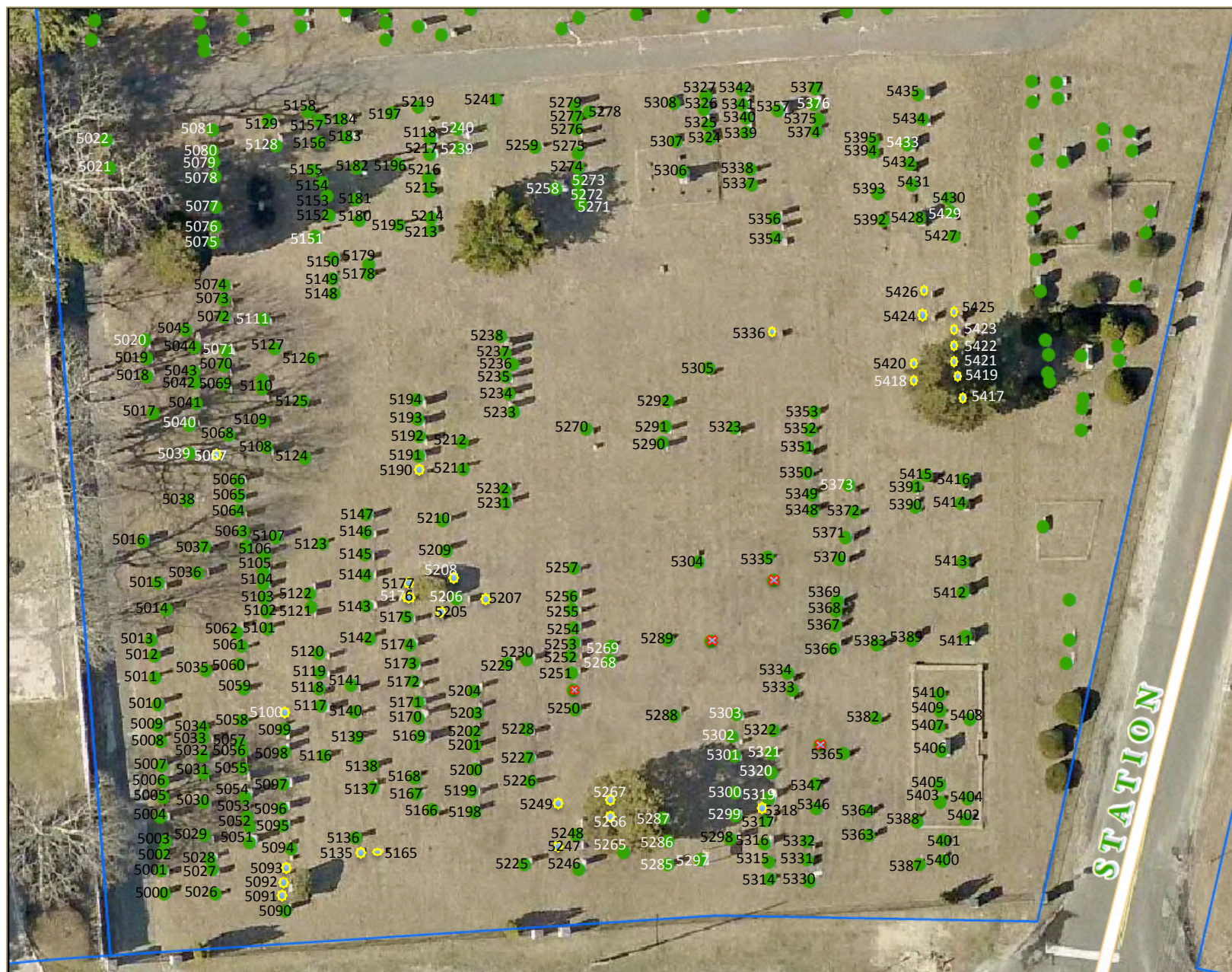
The map marks the location of graves in the southern part of the Cemetery; it is undated but seems to match up to a list that is on file at the New York Genealogical Society. The numbered plot locations that are rectangular seem to from the Newspaper clipping numbers (below). It appears that, at a later date, handwritten names were added to this map.

The Newspaper clippings show the "Inscriptions at Westhampton" provided by L.D Ackereley. The original articles are provided and the Southampton Town's Clerk Office digitized them in 2019. When you view the digitized document, you can search using Ctrl F of Cmd F (if Apple). The lists contain the gravestone inscriptions of the stones found in the oldest part of the Westhampton Cemetery during the period of 1901 – 1907. Neither the Newspaper nor the date-of-publication are known.

The typed list of 267 names is attributed to a list from 1902.

In 2019, Westhampton Cemetery had approximately 800 x 8 grave plots and about 200 x 2 grave plots. Thomas Rogers estimates there are over 6,500 graves in total. Many of the gravesites are still empty but will be used in the future. There is no accurate total of the number of actual burials.

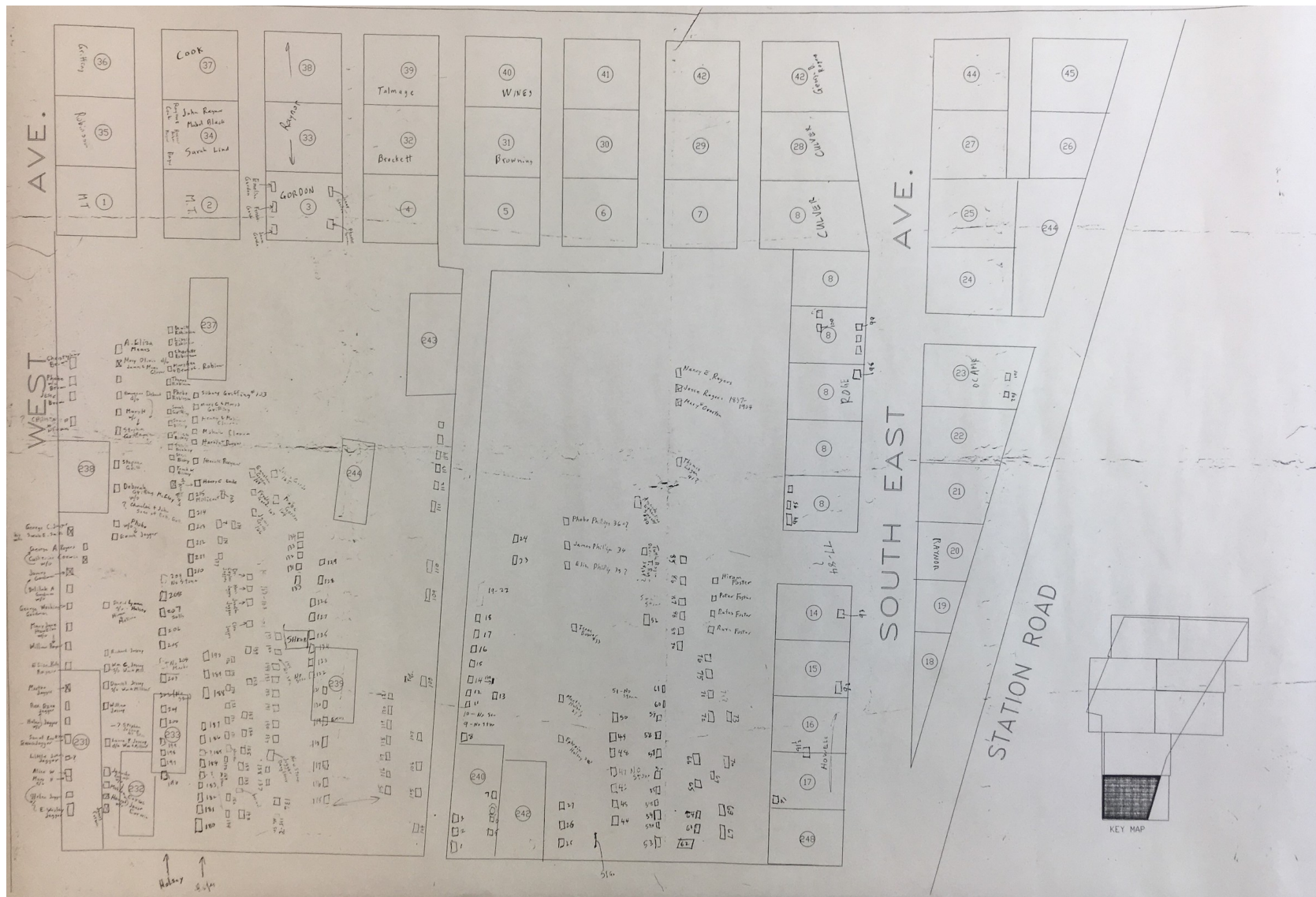
The Town of Southampton has a digitized map that shows the GPS coordinates for every gravestone in the southern part of the Westhampton Cemetery. Each stone was assigned a unique Plot Number. In the spring of 2019, the Westhampton Girl Scouts will survey and clean these stones.

Inscriptions at Westhampton.

In connection with the recent anniversary of the Westhampton Parish, it is proposed to print in this paper the older inscriptions of the vicinity.

Westhampton is to be congratulated for its recent effort to care for the sacred resting place of its dead.

The stones were copied from 1901-'07, and the latter part of a number of them is now buried. The numbers are on file at the New York Genealogical Society, and are therefore retained as filed.

Much time, thought and care has been given to the accompanying notes. If the compiler has been misinformed, she will most heartily accept correction through these columns, and in the many instances where she can give no facts, would be glad to have them in print.

Future generations could then look back to our efforts with deep gratitude, for the stones are, all of them, or at least the older ones, slowly and surely disintegrating.

No. 5. The parents and line of Wm. and Hannah R. (Hallock) Culver, are not known to the compiler. It would be a good deed to name them in this column.

Why No. 13 should be buried so near to Stephen Jagger does not appear, nor can I find his parents. Information on the subject is sought; presumably his father, or grandfather, was Elisha Howell, Sr.

No. 18, Abigail, wife of Capt. Thos. Stephens, an undated stone, is puzzling. If not a Jagger why is she buried in a Jagger row? She could hardly have been the daughter of Stephen Jagger, Esq., for the marriage of his daughter Abigail, is otherwise accounted for. Could she have been the sister of Stephen Jagger, Esqr., before mentioned?

Nos. 23 and 24. John Hocter married Sarah Vincent; neither were natives of America. Their daughter, Mary Hocter, married Luther Cook, of Beaver Dam, whose descendants are with us now.

Of Nos. 25, 26 and 27, the pedigree cannot be given by the compiler. Doubtless that excellent Tuthill genealogist, Mrs. John W. Tuthill, of Speonk, could furnish it, as she has the most complete Tuthill records to be found anywhere near Westhampton.

He has no gravestone at Westhampton, and may not be buried there, but he was obliging enough to leave a will naming 6 children, William, Woodhull, Mary, wife of Sergeant Jessup, (No. 151), Susannah, wife of Silas Jessup, of Quogue, Sophia, and Harriet Brewster.

Perhaps Nathaniel Raynor; No. 70, was brother of Wm. Raynor (who married Mary Pierson) who was son of Wm. and Esther (Woodhull) Kaynor, Nos. 60 and 61.

All the other Millicents traceable, go back to Millicent (Rogers) Halsey, (Nos. 105 and 106); perhaps No. 69 does also.

The Culver lineage is desired of No. 72; his wife was Lydia Brewster, and mother of No. 76.

Frank, said to have been brother of Frederick Hallock, of Quogue, and Franklin, (No. 2).

The father of Nathan Bishop, No. 153, was John, according to Howell's History of Southampton, but the Suffolk Portrait and Biographical History calls him David, I think. Wanted his true lineage.

No. 92, Dennis K. Halsey, was son of Harvey Walter and Sarah L. Kimberly (Nos. 134 and 138), grandson of Wm. H. and Susannah (Jagger) Halsey, who was son of Cornelius and Millicent (Rogers) Halsey, see Nos. 126 and 127, and 106 and 105.

No. 105, Millicent (5), wife of the said Cornelius Halsey, was daughter of Capt. Obadiah (4) and Abigail (Herrick) Rogers, Capt. Obadiah (4), being the 4th Rogers, of his Christian name. Every Millicent in this vicinity that the writer has been able to trace, descends from Millicent Rogers.

No. 107, Mary, wife of Wm. Albertson, b. 9 Jan. 1756, was daughter of Nos. 106 and 105. Probably Wm. Albertson remarried after Mary's death.

Cornelius and Millicent Halsey had a grandchild, Miriam, who married Jonathan Cook; Miriam being buried at Quogue. She had a daughter, Emeline Cook; could she have been No. 110, Emeline Cook Russell?

No. 108, Eunice, wife of Nathan Herrick, who was probably buried at Quogue (No. 151). She does not seem to have been traced. Abigail, sister of Nathan Herrick above, was the mother of Millicent (Rogers) Halsey, but why was Mistress Eunice buried at Westhampton, and not at Quogue?

The said Mary Raynor was daughter of Wm. and Mary (Pierson) Raynor, and granddaughter of Wm. (5) and Esther (Woodhull) Raynor, great granddaughter of Jonathan (4) Raynor, Jonathan (3), Thurston (2), Thurston (1), all of the Town of Southampton. Proof of Sergeant Richard Jessup's line is desired.

No. 122, Wm. Halsey, Jr., was born Sept. 13, 1785; and was son of Nos. 127 and 126, and grandson of Nos. 106 and 105, Cornelius and Millicent (Rogers) Halsey.

The birth date of Wm. Halsey, Jr., is not given in the Halsey genealogy, but was obtained through the courtesy of Miss Harriet Raynor, of Apaucuck Neck.

No. 126, Susanna, wife of Wm. Halsey, born 25 July, 1755, was daughter of Stephen Jagger, of Tanner's Neck, Westhampton, and his 1st wife, Martha Pierson, the said Stephen being son of Jonathan (3) Jagger, of Southampton, John (2), Jeremiah (1).

No. 125, Susan Hart, was daughter of Nos. 127 and 128, and wife of Chas. Hart, their daughter (ie. daughter of Chas. and Susan Hart), Julia A. Halsey, married George Halsey.

George Halsey, above mentioned, is called George O. Halsey in the Halsey Genealogy; he died in Riverhead, was son of Peter Halsey, of Southampton, and later of Cairo, N. Y.; grandson of Zebulon Halsey, of Wickapogue, who was son of Deacon Josiah Halsey, of Wickapogue, and grandson of Josiah and Sarah (Topping) Halsey, son of Thomas (6) and Mary Halsey, of Southampton (see note to No. 106).

Nos. 123 and 124 were children of Julia Ann Hart, and her husband, George O. Halsey, above.

Presumably the said George O. Halsey is buried at Riverhead.

Halsey, who married I. McElhone, of Ellenville.

No. 135, Stephen Jessup, married Abigail Albertson, No. 136 (her line not forthcoming). The said Stephen Jessup was doubtless son of John (4) Jessup (Isaac (3), John (2), John (1), and his wife Phoebe. Of Stephen's children we are sure of but one, William, baptized at Mattituck, but probably Sergeant Richard Jessup was another of Stephen's sons, see note, and beyond.

Nos. 137 and 138 may have been recorded in the lost Brewster Bible, once known to have been at Quogue.

No. 144, Deacon Enoch Jagger, was son of Stephen (4) and Miriam (Wickes) Jagger, (Youth (3), John (2), Jeremiah (1).) This lineage is wrong in Howell's History of Southampton, according to the mss. of the Westhampton Jagger Records. Deacon Enoch above married 1st Mehitable Fanning, No. 143; 2nd, Abigail Post (142) and 3d. Persis (141). Her maiden name seems lost, she had no Jagger issue, but by her first husband is said to have had a son, Constant Terry. Further information sought. No. 140 was son of 144 and 142, and married 139, Jane E. Hawkins, of Moriches.

No. 147, Warren Goodale, came of a family early at Southampton, but his lineage has not been found by the writer; his wife, Anne, was daughter of Deacon Enoch Jagger, and 2nd wife, Abigail Post (Nos. 144 and 142). The other children of Enoch and Abigail, above, were: Mehitable, who married John Raynor; Daniel Marsh (No. 140), before mentioned; Wm. Post (No. 145); Phoebe (No. 146); Mary, who married Stephen F. Griffing, (see beyond), and James Jagger. No. 148 doubtless descended from Lydia, sister of Wm. Brewster, and her husband Jeremiah Culver.

For 151, see notes ante to Nos. 115 and 135.

No. 153, Nathan Bishop, was, according to the 2d edition of Howell's History of Southampton, son of John (4) Bishop, Samuel (3), John (2), Richard (1). According to the "Portrait and Biographical History of Suffolk County" his father's name was, I think, David.

Howell was a very accurate historian, but the Portrait and Biographical History, above mentioned, is known to be wrong in several instances. It is true that the 1st edition of Howell's History contained several errors, doubtless many of them surmises, when the family had not responded about their genealogies to the author of that work. It would be interesting to know why Nathan was supposed to be son of David, and to have his line, whatever it was, back to Richard Bishop, of Salem, Mass., the progenitor of this family of Long Island Bishops. I have never been able to find a single person who knew the name of Nathan's father.

No. 152, Huldah (5), wife of Nathan Bishop, descended from Edward (1) Culver, in the line of Gersham (2), Moses (3), and James (4) Culver.

No. 154 was the eldest son of 152 and 153, and was one of twelve children.

No. 155, Elihu (6) Raynor, married Elizabeth Albertson (line unknown).

No. 156, Elihu, above, was son of Nathan (5) and Jerusha (Bowers) Raynor, grandson of Jonathan (4), Jonathan (3), Thurston (2), Thurston (1).

No. 157, Nancy Raynor, was one of the daughters of Nos. 155 and 156.

158 and 159 have not as yet been placed, but doubtless many people at Westhampton know their lineage, and it is hoped some kind friend will convey the knowledge to this column.

Speonk; the surname of his wife Mary,
No. 170, does not appear. Who was
she? David was son of Jonathan Hal-
sey, of Speonk, and his wife, Jane
Cooper, grandson of Abrrham (4) and
Anny (Halsey) Halsey, who was a
great grandson of the 1st Thomas Hal-
sey, of Southampton.

No. 172, William Stephens, of Po-
tunk, was brother of Thomas Stephens,
of Southampton, who married Mehit-
able Halsey, and of Edward Stephens,
of Quogue, (Quogue, No. 56), who
married Martha Rogers.

Their father, Capt. Thomas (3)
Stephens, of Quogue, married 1st Han-
nah Cooper, in all probability, and 2d
Abigail, possibly a Jagger (see West-
hampton stone, No. 18). Who was
Abigail, and what issue did both she
and Hannah leave?

There is a most interesting old house
at Quogue, said to have belonged to
the Stephens family there.

The first of the race was another
Capt. Thos. (1) Stephens, of Southamp-
ton, who married Elizabeth, daughter
of Ellis Cook.

Chas. Stevens (Stephens), No. 175,
was of Potunk, and married Nancy, No.
174, daughter of John and Elizabeth
(Brewster) Howell, and sister of Major
John Mitchell Howell, of Aetna-
bonack.

Charles Stevens, above, was son of
Wm., of Potunk, No. 172. Was not
the surname of his mother Abigail, No.
170, Brewster?

Abraham Stevens (No. 214), son of
the said Charles and Nancy, was father
of Chas. Hance, 171, by his 1st wife,
Hannah Raynor, while Millicent Ray-
nor, (who married 1st Wm. Jessup)
was the 2d wife of the said Abraham
Stevens (No. 214), and mother of No.
176, Abraham Howell Stevens.

No. 177, Lucinda, wife of John Good-
ale, was not the daughter-in-law of
Anna Jagger, wife of Warren Goodale,
and the writer has not been able to
trace either herself or her husband.
Any facts concerning the lineage of
either Mr. or Mrs. Goodale, above,
will be gladly received for this column.

father of Mehlon Corwin, of whom

No. 179, Samuel Robinson, came within the memory of some now living from Red Creek. One of his children, Samuel, returned to Red Creek, while other descendants are still among us.

No. 187, Thomas Nicholas Rogers, is said to have been son of Thomas Rogers, of Moriches, the family coming originally from Connecticut. His wife, Elizabeth, was daughter of Wm. and Susannah Halsey, (Nos. 127 and 128). They had, according to the Halsey Genealogy, Alexander, Thomas, Desiah (No. 188), Caroline E. (No. 189), Frances Overton (No. 186), David C. (190), and Lester G. (No. 180), Kesia, George, and Byron, who are perhaps not named in proper order.

Lester G. Rogers, No. 180, married Elizabeth, No. 181, daughter of Wm. and Harriet (Jagger) Raynor, niece of Woodhull Raynor (No. 78).

Through his mother, Elizabeth Halsey, Lester G. Rogers was descended from the Rogers family, of Southampton, his greatgrandmother being Millicent (Rogers) Halsey, No. 105. Besides John N. and Mary G. (Nos. 182 and 183), Lester G. Rogers had issue David, Frances, Larsen, Jennie B. and Millicent. The old Rogers homestead is at Beaver Dam.

Charity (205) was his sister, they were children of Elihu and Elizabeth (Albertson) Raynor (Nos. 155 and 156), grandchildren of Nathan and Jerusha (Bowers) Raynor, Nathan being son of Jonathan and Irene (Herrick) Raynor.

Wm. Raynor (208) must have been son of Jotham (206), and was born 18 Feb., 1805. His wife, Sarah A. Robinson, of Patchogue, was perhaps 209.

Abraham Stevens (214) was son of Chas. and Nancy (Howell) Stevens (175 and 174) and grandson of Wm. Stevens (172). Abraham married 1st Hannah Raynor (213) and 2nd her sister, Millicent (215), widow of Wm. Jessup, of whom hereafter. Hannah and Millicent were daughters of Jotham Raynor (206). Their Albertson forebears are desired.

Richard Stevens (211) was brother of Abraham Stevens (214), and Sarah Stevens (210), and Sina (212) were children of Abraham and Hannah Stevens above.

EDITOR OF CHRONICLE:

I noticed some few weeks ago, in the CHRONICLE, and again in last week's issue, some inscriptions on head stones in our cemetery, and a request for information. Do not know as I can give much information that will interest the public, but will do what I can. The first row of graves on the right side of the middle gate is where Capt. Franklin Bishop, his wife, Laura, and son, James lie; their daughter, Hannah, married John Hawkins, of West Moriches. She died some 30 years ago, and as her husband at that time had no lot in a public cemetery her remains were brought here and buried beside her parents. Recently Mr. Hawkins purchased a lot in the Moriches Cemetery, and had the remains of his first wife, Hannah Bishop, removed there. The next row north contain the remains of the forefathers of the present Jagger family, who came here from Southampton and after a time settled at what is called Tanner's Neck. The later generation of Jaggers are buried in the western part of the old cemetery.

The Ephriam Halsey spoken of in your last issue (No. 28), I presume was the forefather of most of the Halsey's who did live in this vicinity (Oneck). The Arnolds mentioned in Nos. 30 and 32 I know nothing about and do not believe anyone living in this neighborhood now knows anything about them.

Isaac Bower mentioned (No. 33), I know nothing about, but remember of my parents speaking about a Bower family living about here before they came here in 1800. No. 34, James C. Phillips, was son of Stephen Phillips, who was born in East Quogue (called 4th Neck at that time). His first wife, Phoebe, was the daughter of Nathaniel and Rejoice Corwin, who used to live where Wm. King now lives. Do not know who were the parents of his second wife. She was a Munsell, of Bellport. Tuttle Rogers and son, David, resided near Speonk.
