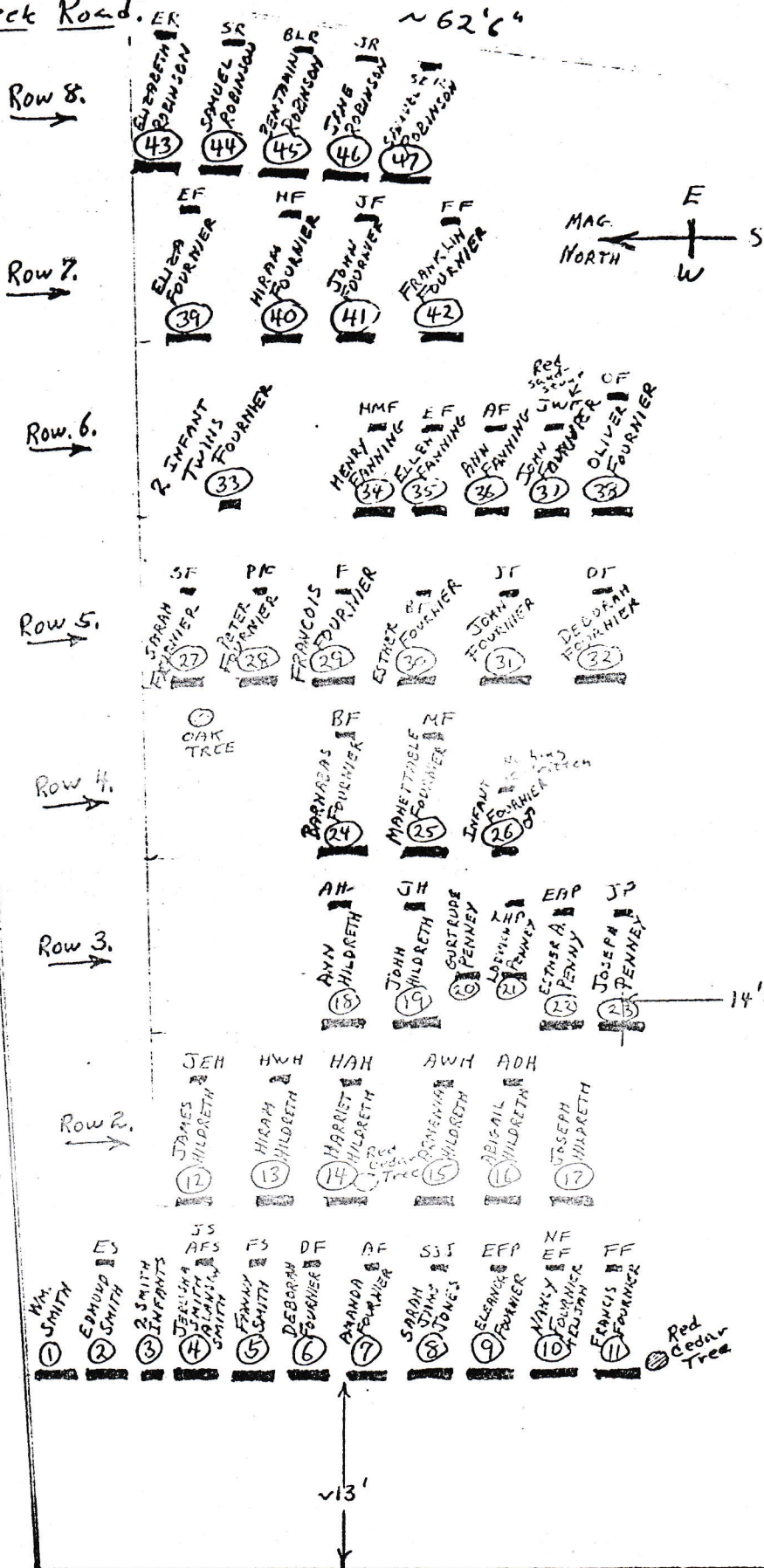

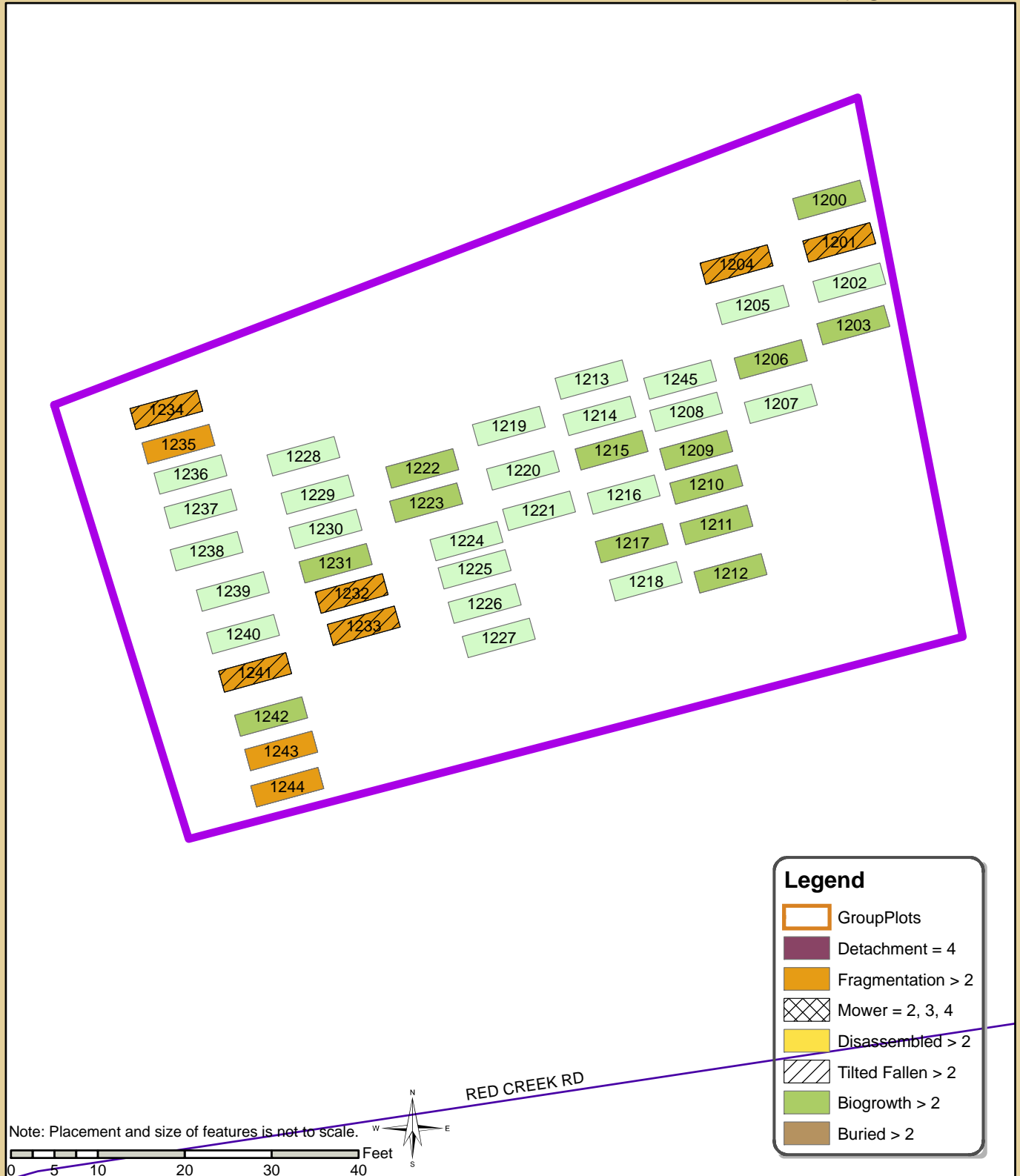

## Pattern of Key Conditions

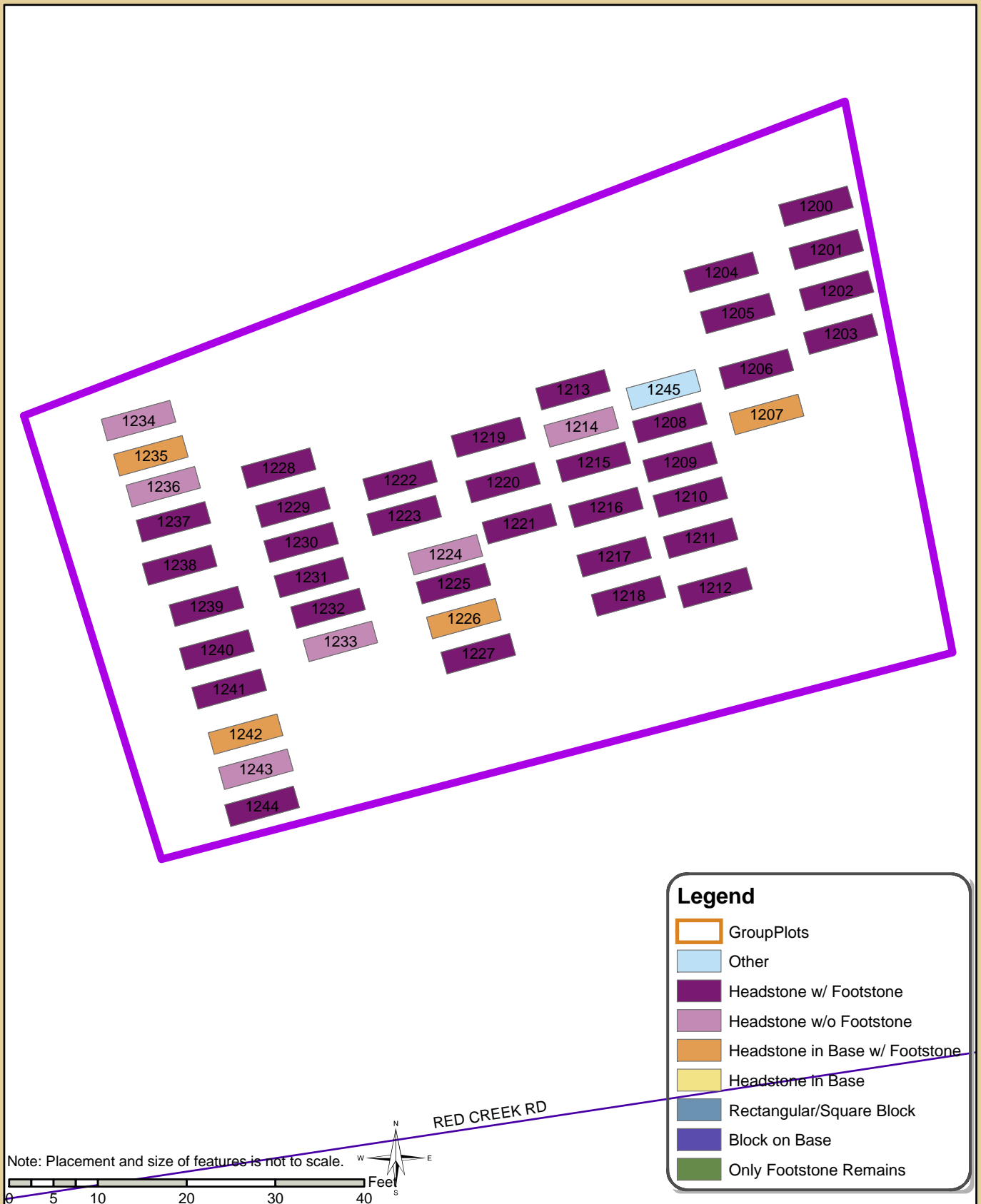
If several conditions are present, the top (most serious or most remarkable) condition covers the polygon.



Note: Placement and size of features is not to scale.

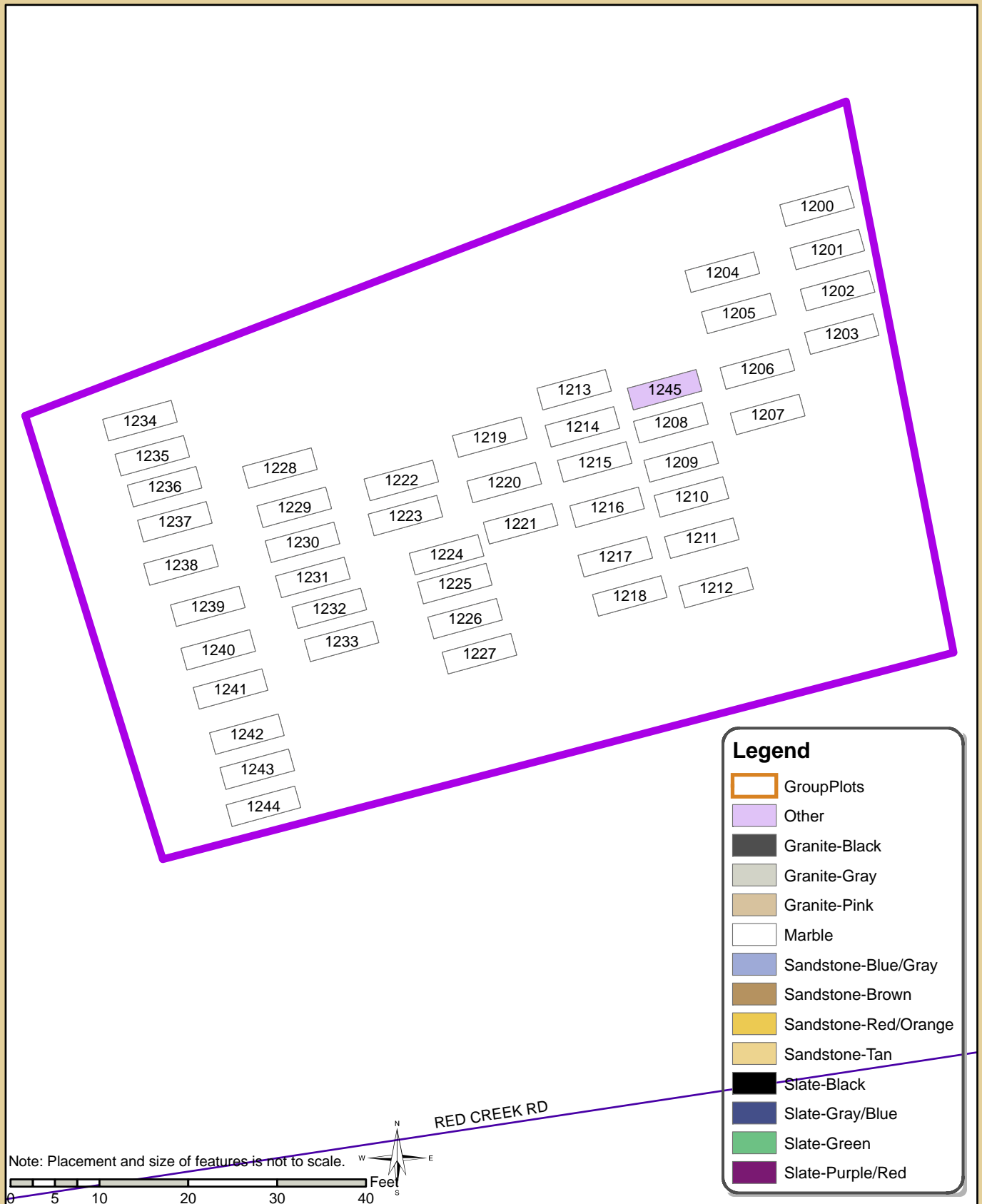
