As a Christian he aimed to keep his heart with all diligence and to adorn the doctrine of God, his Saviour in all things. As a Divine he was mighty in the Scriptures and had investigated the whole field of theological science. As a preacher he was instructive discriminating and pungent. And as a pastor he was faithful to his flock, and abounded in all the duties of the sacred office. His death was peaceful and happy. This stone was erected as a testimony of respect and affection by
