Sacred to the memory of a reverend father this monument is erected as a tribute of filial duty and respect by a son. James Howell was born at Southampton Oct. 15, 1731. Departed this life Dec. 12, 1808. James Howell was one of the earliest settlers of Sag Harbor. (He kept the house which is on the present site of the American Hotel, as a tavern. There the officers commanding the British garrison had headquarters during the Revolution.)
